

The Guidelines for the Setting of the Globalization Committee for Bachelor's Program in Advanced Material Sciences

Approved by the Affairs Meeting of Bachelor's Program in Advanced Material Sciences on June 4th, 2019

Article 1

Bachelor's Program in Advanced Material Sciences College of Science of Tamkang University (Hereinafter referred to as "the Program") has founded the Globalization Committee (Hereinafter referred to as "the Committee") for enhancing international academic exchange and cooperation, promoting the globalization of learning environments and broadening students' horizon.

Article 2

The chairman of the program is the Natural Member and Convener. Three full-time teachers from College of Science from are the Natural Members, who serves for the Committee for a year. The tenure is subject to selection and can be extended.

Article 3

The Committee is responsible for the followings:

1. Making plans for the international academic exchange and cooperation.
2. Making plans and reviewing the direction and strategies for globalization.
3. Making plans or regulations, evaluating and promoting any related international affairs
4. Assisting school in the policy-making and promoting.

Article 4

The Committee meets at least once each semester. Provisional meeting will be hold if necessary. The chairman of the program can invite the professional or persons involved to attend the meeting.

Article 5

Any decision needs to be supported by more than half of the present members. The present members need to be more than half of the whole committee.

The Guidelines and any future amendment come into effect after being approved by Affairs Meeting of Bachelor's Program in Advanced Material Sciences.
